
### **Financial Summary**

The net asset value (NAV) per share at 30 September was 2,018 pence. The year to date NAV total return was 1.7% and the share price total return was -11.2%. Over the same period, the Company's two indices; RPI plus 3% and MSCI All Country World Index (50% Sterling) were up +3.1% and +2.0% respectively. The average net quoted equity exposure for the year to date was 43%. The share price closed at 1,858 pence per share.




